<b>Morning</b> 	<p><b>ENGLISH</b></p> <p>Warm up: <a href="#">Under the deep blue sea</a></p> <p>Warm up 2: <a href="#">Rhyming words freeze</a></p> <p>We are learning to broaden our vocabulary, becoming familiar with language associated with pirates.</p> <p><b>Task 1:</b> <a href="#">View pirate words, how to pronounce them and what they mean.</a></p>  <p><b>Task 2:</b> Research your own pirate name using the <a href="#">scaffold here</a> (ask an adult or older sibling to assist)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Let everyone at home know your new name and use it in conversations with them all day long.</li> <li>Create a pirate mini world &amp; talk like a pirate all day long.</li> </ol>	<p><b>ENGLISH</b></p> <p>Warm up: <a href="#">Silly Pirate Song</a></p> <p>Warm up 2: <a href="#">Syllable song</a></p> <p>We are learning to listen to and respond to stories demonstrating imagination and our understanding of what the story is about.</p> <p><b>Task 1:</b> <a href="#">View How I became a pirate</a></p> <p><b>Task 2:</b> Imagine you are a pirate too! Draw a picture of what you might see through your own telescope.</p> <p><a href="#">See scaffold here</a> or draw directly over in your Seesaw activities.</p>  <p>Optional extra: Decorate your own telescope.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><a href="#">Short clip</a></li> </ol> <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><a href="#">Trickier fancier telescope for fun!</a></li> </ol>	<p><b>ENGLISH</b></p> <p>Warm up: <a href="#">We are the pirates</a></p> <p>Warm up 2: <a href="#">Letter and sound matching</a></p> <p>We are learning to read and create treasure maps, building our writing skills and imagination through play.</p> <p><b>Task 1:</b> Let's join <a href="#">Captain Jay on a treasure hunt</a></p>  <p><b>Task 2: Let's make our own treasure maps</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Inside a small box put some treasures such as small stones, flowers, metallic or shiny things.</li> <li>Hide the box somewhere in your home.</li> <li>Draw a pirate map to help your family find the treasure.</li> </ol> <p><a href="#">Guide for how to make a treasure map is here.</a></p>

<p>Middle</p> 	<p><b>MATHEMATICS</b></p> <p><b>Warm up:</b> <a href="#">Pirate Ship 1,2,3</a></p> <p>We are learning to investigate angles through position and direction.</p> <p><b>Task 1:</b> Watch a video from Ms Martin and play along with her Cannonball game.</p>  <p><b>Task 2:</b> Watch <a href="#">Pop stick catapult</a></p> <p>You can make the catapult from the video, or use recyclable materials to design and make your own launcher.</p> 	<p><b>MATHEMATICS</b></p> <p><b>Warm up:</b> <a href="#">Wiggles: A sailor went to sea, sea, sea</a></p> <p>We are learning to match shapes and consider how to combine shapes to solve problems.</p> <p><b>Task 1:</b> Watch a video from Ms Martin designing and making a boat that floats from recyclable materials.</p>  <p><b>Task 2:</b> Practice identifying and matching shapes pirate-style!
